Founded in 1991 by violinist Beth Spendlove, and firmly rooted in the musical landscape of East Anglia, members of the Kingfisher String Quartet have become well known to audiences for their diverse programming which encompasses piano trios with the UK based pianist Nigel Clayton, sextets & octets, through to works for strings and wind.

The group is regularly invited to give recitals and has performed for the Aldeburgh Arts & Literary Society, Maldon Arts, Melford Music, Bury Theatre Royal and at the Chelmsford Festival. Further afield, they have performed at Westminster Hall, Guildhall City of London, for Brighton New Music and in Chamber Music festivals in France.

Calling on principal players from the Kingfisher Sinfonietta, the group also expands to perform larger scale works and enjoys collaborating with many of East Anglia's most eminent choral societies and vocal groups.
